# PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Parents of students involved in Lads to Leaders have responsibilities in helping their child and or children set goals, accomplish those goals, and realize their responsibility.

1. Know what your child has signed up to do and help him/her set realistic goals. **Be sure your child has read and knows the rules of his/her events.** Each event has a specific set of guidelines that must be followed. 2. Know the coordinators of each event that your child is involved with.
3. Encourage and assist your child in attending all meetings of his/her event. For year-round or individual events, encourage your child to “keep on working” a little bit at a time in his/her individual work projects.
4. Help your child to become more responsible by closely supervising your child’s work and attendance. The training and ongoing work is the heart of Lads to Leaders. Rather than wait and do everything a few weeks before convention, encourage ongoing work of projects. **It is recommended that time is set aside each day for your child to work on Lads to Leader/Leaderettes.**
5. See that your child has adequate preparation time and supplies to accomplish his/her goals.
6. Remember to check the Lads to Leaders bulletin board regularly for lists and verify all information.
7. Remember to have fun with your child and enjoy this growing experience. Remember our long-term goal for every child and adult....become a Christian, live a faithful Christian life and get to Heaven!
